### **WARRANTY AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS**

<b>SPRINGS -</b>	<b>3 YEARS</b>
<b>HARDWARE-</b>	<b>5 YEARS</b>
<b>DOOR-</b>	<b>15 YEARS</b>
<b>ANODIZED FINISH-</b>	<b>15 YEARS</b>

Must be kept clean to keep your finish warranty valid.

Proper Maintenance Instruction.

Anodized aluminum is easy to clean. Just hose down the surface with water using moderate pressure (use Garden hose NOT a pressure washer). Wash with a mild detergent or a car wash type soap cleaner. Use a very soft cloth or sponge (non-abrasive type). Wash/wipe left to right going with the brushed grain surface, VS up/down swirl motion. This is the recommended way to avoid scratching or leaving swirl marks. Rinse thoroughly when finished.

To protect and polish the Clear Anodized surface, it is Highly recommended that you use a Stainless steel/Aluminum polish, which is easily found at The Home Depot and Lowes stores. ZEP brand works well and the stores have other brands that will do a similar job.

Please follow instructions found on the can. It is recommended to do this twice a year.

If you are near the ocean/beach in a salt type of environment, you should wash your door monthly to avoid the Salt build up and residues.

Document each time you clean your Clear Anodized Brushed Aluminum Garage Door. Required at least Annually in the non-salt environments and Monthly in Salt/Beach coastal environments.
